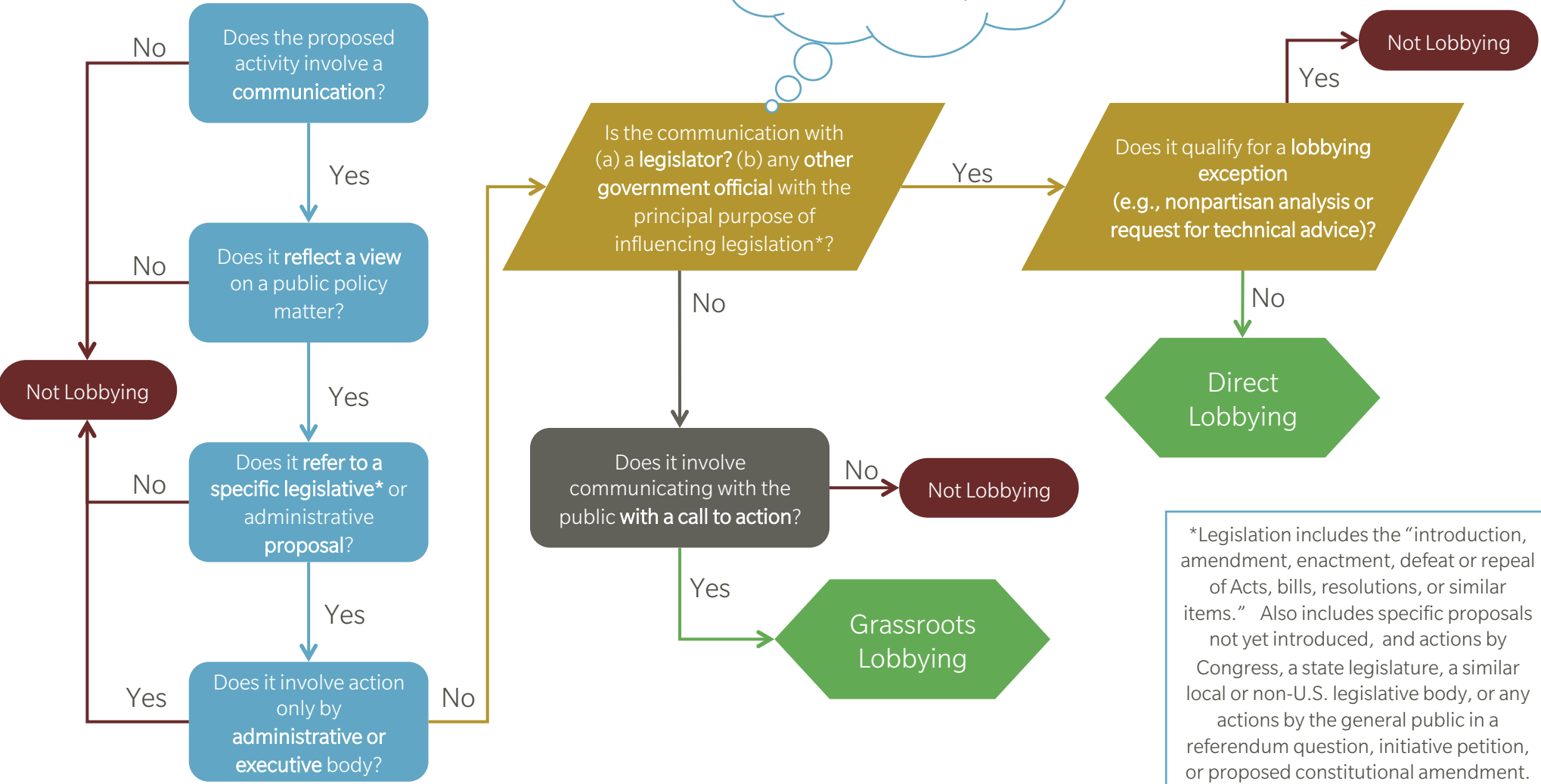


Start Here



Preparation for communication counts: drafting bills, strategizing with allies, writing factsheets/talking points, related travel costs, etc.

*Legislation includes the “introduction, amendment, enactment, defeat or repeal of Acts, bills, resolutions, or similar items.” Also includes specific proposals not yet introduced, and actions by Congress, a state legislature, a similar local or non-U.S. legislative body, or any actions by the general public in a referendum question, initiative petition, or proposed constitutional amendment. Appropriations bills, legislative confirmation of administrative nominees, and model legislation also count for this purpose.
